

HIV Specialty Care Unit

Services and Supports

- Consultation and orders from the Infectious Disease Physician that performs clinical rounds in the center once per week and is on call 24/7 for consultation on program residents.
- Designated HIV Program Social Worker.
- Specialized and individualized medication and antiviral regimens.
- Specific Clinical Programming and Activities on the Unit including weekly planned education/group sessions about living with HIV, grief support, recovery skills and coping skills
- Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy
- Weekly one-on-one mental health counseling
- On-site APRN services three times per week
- Onsite weekly Connection with Money Follows the Person for individual discharge planning involving housing supports
- Collaboration with The Village for Families and Children for social supports and wrap-around services.
- Complex Wound Care
- Consistent nursing staff on the unit for continuity of care
- I.V. Therapy
- Nutritional Counseling with our full time onsite Dietitian
- Transitional Counseling, Post Discharge follow-up, and Social Services Support through our program's full time Social Worker
- Individual and Group Substance Abuse Counseling through our iRecovery Pro
